- II. Board member Mikal Ramadan officially submitted his resignation from the board allowing Kristen Kremer to immediately assume an interim SAC position prior to her official start on July 1.
- III. The SACC appointed Kelly Zimdars and Jay Murphy to the newly formed State Education Committee (SEC) headed up by Justin Slife. The SEC has non-voting status on the SAC.
- IV. State Financial Update Current balance approximately \$35,000. We're committed to funding about \$15,000 to the SEC this first year to get the program launched. In addition, after regular state expenses including Regional head tax, SACC travel, and judges' assignment fees our balance is expected to be approximately \$7,000. Future SEC funding will depend on the state's financial profile.
